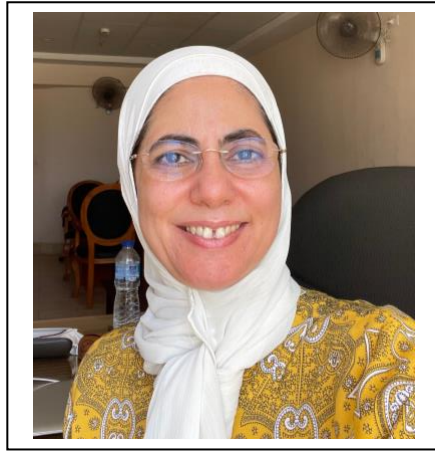


Dr. Nermien E Waly, MBBCh., MSc., PhD, MD.
